Brite Idea: God is faithful.

Brite Idea: God faithfully provides for us.

He Question: How is God able to provide what we need?

Daniel in the Lion's Den (Daniel 6)

Brite Idea: God is always with us.

- He Question: How can God always be with us?
- God is omnipresent, which means He is everywhere all the time. He is faithful to those who trust Him.

Ezekiel (Ezekiel 37:1-14)

Brite Idea: God gives new life.

- He Question: Who is in charge of life and death?
- God is the giver of all life. Death came into the world because of sin, but God is greater than death. He gives us new life through Jesus and gives us the opportunity to have eternal life.

We Question: How does God's presence help us when we are scared?

God knows everything and He created us, so He knows exactly what

we need. He knows what we are going through. Even if He doesn't

WEEK 1 God is faithful. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Lamentations 3:22-23 How do you feel knowing that God will always be faithful?	Make a faithfulness chart. Write down how God has been faithful to your family. Put it up in your house as a reminder.	PSALM 117:2 What does the word steadfast mean?	As a family, talk about how you can show faithfulness to God together. Maybe commit to praying together, attending church, etc.	Have each family member share something they really want. Discuss the difference between needs/wants. READ TOGETHER: 1 Kings 17 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 2 God faithfully provides for us. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Matthew 6:25-33 How does God provide for the flowers and birds? How does He provide for us?	Go on a walk and observe the differ- ent ways that God cares for our world. Discuss how much more He cares of us.	PSALM 117:2 How long will God be faithful to us?	Look for opportunities to serve those in need together, e.g., volunteer at a food bank or clothing drive, etc.	Go to the zoo and observe the lions or watch a documentary about lions. READ TOGETHER: Daniel 6 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 3 God is always with us. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Isaiah 41:10 How does knowing God is always with you help you?	Talk about hard times you have been through as a family. Talk about where God was faithful and with you during those times.	PSALM 117:2 Describe God's love for us.	Have each family member share a fear they have. Then pray for each person individually.	Share the craziest dream you have ever had. READ TOGETHER: Ezekiel 37:1-14 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
WEEK 4 God gives us new life. What does this mean for me?	READ TOGETHER: Ezekiel 26:36 What kind of heart do you have? A stubborn heart or a responsive heart?	Plant some winter seeds together and watch them grow. Remember that we were dead and through Jesus, we have new life.	PSALM 117:2 How do you feel knowing that God will always be faithful to us and love us?	Clearly share the Gospel message with your family and discuss any questions.	Share the best news you have ever received. READ TOGETHER: Malachi 3:1-3 and Isaiah 9:6-7 DISCUSS: What does this teach us about God?
