3. How does Scripture shine light in dark places (v. 19)?
4. How does Peter describe the Scriptures in verses 20-21?

Application Questions

1. Since Scripture is the foundation of our faith, how can you keep Scripture central in your life? What obstacles keep you from reading the Bible consistently?
2. What role does community play in properly understanding the Scriptures according to the passage?
3. How can we encourage one another to keep the truths of Scripture front and center in our thinking?
