- 4. How does Peter describe the Scriptures in verses 20-21?

Application Questions

- 1. Since Scripture is the foundation of our faith, how can you keep Scripture central in your life? What obstacles keep you from reading the Bible consistently?
- 2. What role does community play in properly understanding the Scriptures according to the passage?
- 3. How can we encourage one another to keep the truths of Scripture front and center in our thinking?
