4 Steps:

- A) Read your passage for the day and write it out in your notebook word for word.
- **B)** Meditate on what the passage says and re-write the passage in your own words.
- **C)** Think through what the passage means and write some of the implications of what it means in your notebook.
- **D)** Application: After you find out what the passage says and means, it is vital that you write out how it applies to your life. Unapplied knowledge is useless. Think of at least 1-2 specific applications that this passage has for your life at this time.

Prayer: -Pray that during the day you'll apply these principles from God's Word to your life.

Example:

A) Isaíah 41:10 – So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.

B) Isaíah 41:10 – You don't ever need to be scared or intimidated, because 1, God, am there with you. Don't let circumstances discourage you, because 1 will take care of you. I will give you the strength and stamina that you need and I will keep you going and will not let you go. I have a strong grip on your life.

C) This means that 1) 1 am never alone without God...even in my toughest situations, God will be there for me. 2) God wants me to have courage in the midst of my fears because of His presence in my life. 3) God will give me the strength and the help to do what He wants me to do. 4) God won't let go of me...even in my weakest points.

D) Applications:

- <u>I need to remember that God is right there for me when I know I should stand up for Him in my class</u>, at that meeting, on my team, etc.
- God is with me and will give me the strength to say "no" to those temptations that I am experiencing with my friends as they try to pull me back into the party scene.
- <u>I won't ever give up in my faith, even when it is difficult, because I know that God has the</u> strength that I need and will help me persevere.
